

SUE FOR BOSTON HOTEL SITE

New England Interests Move to Halt Sale to Statler Company.

BOSTON, May 26.—A bill in equity to enjoin the New York, New Haven & Hartford Railroad Company from selling certain land in the Park Square section to the Statler Hotel Company, Inc., of New York, was filed in the Supreme Court today by the Preferred Underwriters, Inc., and the Bostonia, Inc.

The complaint said that the petitioners had paid for an option, and had subsequently entered into a contract for the land, agreeing to pay \$1,505,000 and other considerations, only to learn that the Directors of the New Haven road had begun negotiations to sell the land to the Statler Company.

Both the Statler interests and the petitioners, with which hotel interests of New York, Massachusetts and Maine are associated, seek to build a new hotel of 1,000 or more rooms.

An order of notice returnable June 2 was issued.
